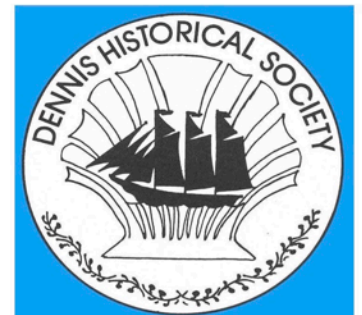

MY DEAR BROTHER

I THOUGHT I WOULD WRITE YOU WE ALL SMART AND I HOPE YOU
ARE THE SAME DO YOU HAVE ENY ICE WE HAVE A LITTLE ICE
AUNT THANKFUL HAS COME HOME AND SHE IS NOT GOING TO STOP
I WISH YOU HAPPY NEW YEAR SET IS CUNNING AS EVER HAVE YOU
ANY CORNS YET I HAVE BEEN OVER TO GRANDFATHER TO NIGHT I
CANT THINK OF ENY THING ELSE SO GOOD BY
