

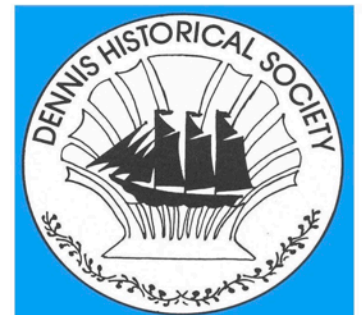
[1875-04-07; copy of letter from Oliver Ames to Judge of Probate, J. M. Day:]

Dear sir

Mr Baker has shown me a letter from you in regard to suit against Page-Richardson & Co. What I propose to do is if your client will press their claim vs. Page-Richardson & Co to the extent of the law. I in consideration of their bringing these Rogues to Justice, will release to them the money laying in the Tremont Bank which I attached as property of Page Richardson & Co.
