“Only two of the captains in this list are living. The list is admittedly incomplete. Yet it nearly equals in number the dwelling houses in the village. If the number of dwellings that have been erected in the last fifty years (or since the decadence of shipping) were eliminated from the total number it is quite possible that the captains sent out from this hamlet up to fifty years ago, equaled in number the dwelling houses at that time.

I wonder how this record compares with that of the other villages on the Cape.
