PROBATE COURT.

To *Louisa M. Crowell*
 of *Dennis* in the County of *Barnstable*,
 and Commonwealth aforesaid.

YOU are appointed guardian of *Minerva E. Crowell, Louis A. Crowell, Gertrude Crowell, Edwin D. Crowell and Mildred Crowell* (having been appointed testamentary guardian by their father *Edwin D. Crowell*, late of said *Dennis*, deceased) all of said *Dennis* minors, with full power and authority to take possession of all real and personal estate of said wards; and

You are required to make and return into said Probate Court, within three months from the date hereof, a true inventory of all the real and personal estate of said wards, which at the time of the making of such inventory shall have come to your possession or knowledge;

To manage and dispose of all such estate according to law and for the best interests of said wards, and faithfully to discharge your trust in relation to such estate, and to the custody, education and maintenance of said wards;

To render, upon oath, a true account of the property in your hands, including the proceeds of all real estate sold or mortgaged by you, and of the management and disposition of all such property, at least once a year, until your trust is fulfilled, unless excused therefrom in any year by said Court;

At the expiration of your trust, to settle your accounts in said Court, or with said wards or their legal representative, and to pay over and deliver all the estate and effects remaining in your hands, or due from you on such settlement, to the person or persons lawfully entitled thereto.
