

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Edwin Tripp of the town of Dennis in the county of Barnstable and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, mortgagee in a certain mortgage given by Michael P. Crotty of Boston in the county of Suffolk in said Commonwealth, to me dated October 31st 1914 in consideration of Four Hundred Dollars paid by Jonathan P. Edwards of said, Dennis the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby assign, transfer, and set over unto the said Jonathan P. Edwards the said mortgage deed, the real estate thereby conveyed, and the note and claim thereby secured.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Jonathan P. Edwards and his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever; subject nevertheless, to the conditions therein contained and to redemption according to law.
