

RETURN REGISTERED LETTER BILL.

Upon the receipt of this Bill at the office of its destination, the Postmaster will at once enter the date of its receipt and ascertain whether a corresponding package of registered letters has been received at his office. If it has he will endorse this Bill *correct*, if it is found so, or note any error or difference which may be found in it, and will then inclose and return it by the first mail to the office from which it was received. If it be found that the corresponding package *has not* been received, he will endorse the Bill *not received* and will return it in the same manner. The Registered Letter Bill will be retained and filed at the office at which it is received.
