

Owen B. Murray

We feel a personal bereavement in the death of Owen B. Murray, Dennis Port, who passed away at his Main Street home Monday after a week's illness, age 60.

Early in life he engaged in the clothing business as clerk for T. F. & Z. H. Small, Ginn's Block, later taking over the business in partnership with his father-in-law, James T. Snow, under the firm name of Snow & Murray, and has assumed the management of the business since the death of Mr. Snow several years ago.

Mr. Murray was selectman of Dennis from 1931 to 1936, was a past master of Mt. Horeb Lodge, A. F. & A. M., a member of Sylvester Baxter R. A. Chapter, and a District Deputy Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Massachusetts; also a director of the Central Cape Cod Kiwanis Club, and had an extensive and intimate acquaintance with the people of the Cape. He possessed a sympathetic nature that endeared himself to all who knew him and enjoyed his confidence and his friendship. His passing brings sadness to a wide circle of friends.

Mr. Murray was son of Mrs. Phebe Murray and the late Timothy Murray of Dennis Port, and besides his aged mother, leaves a widow, Mrs. Nora Murray, two sons, O. Thomas Murray of Dennis Port and Franklin Murray of Orleans, three daughters, Mrs. Dorothy Chase, Mrs. Edith Robbins and Mrs. Harriet Foss, and a sister, Mrs. Mertis Taylor, all of Dennis Port; also eleven grandchildren.

Masonic funeral services were held this afternoon at the West Harwich Baptist Church, Rev. S. J. Riggs officiating.
